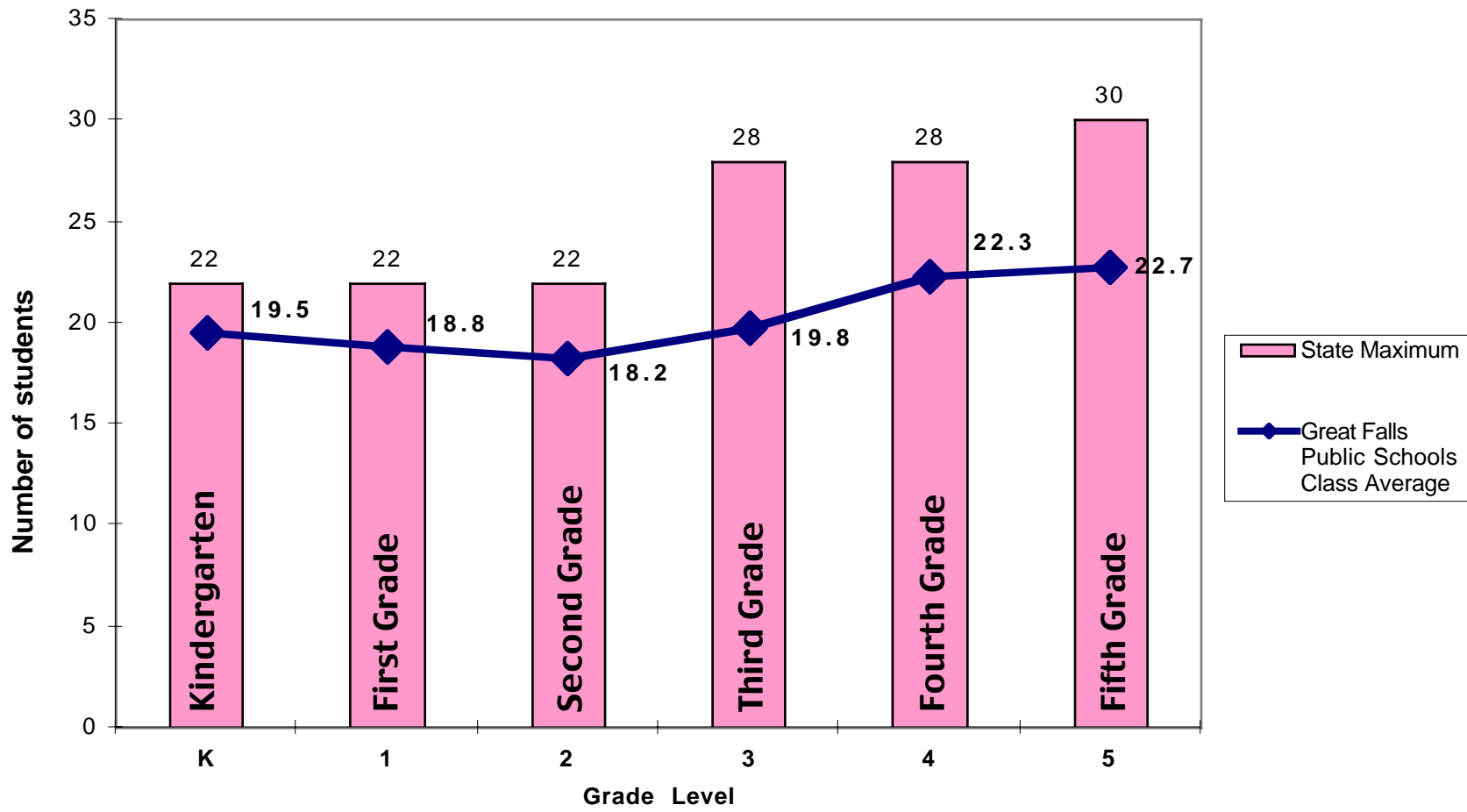


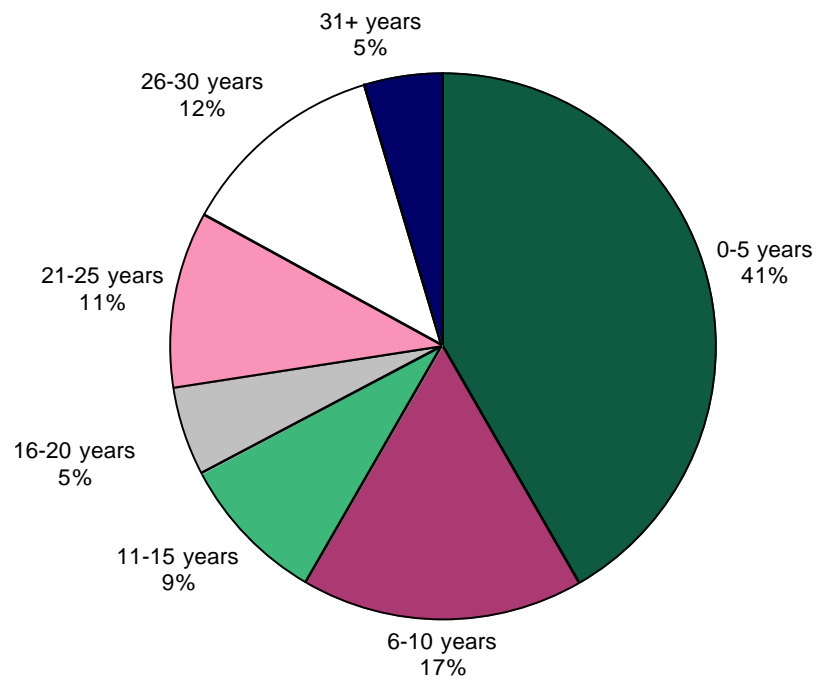
# Average Class Size



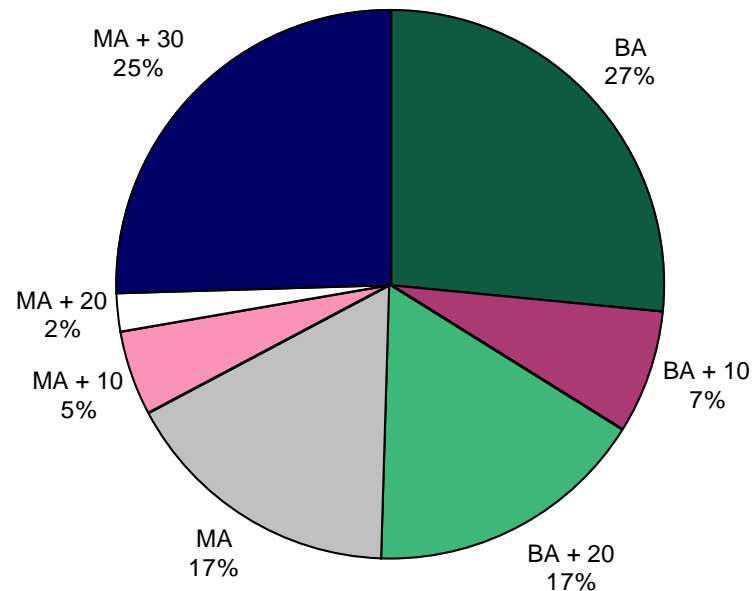

# Teacher Experience/Education 2000-01

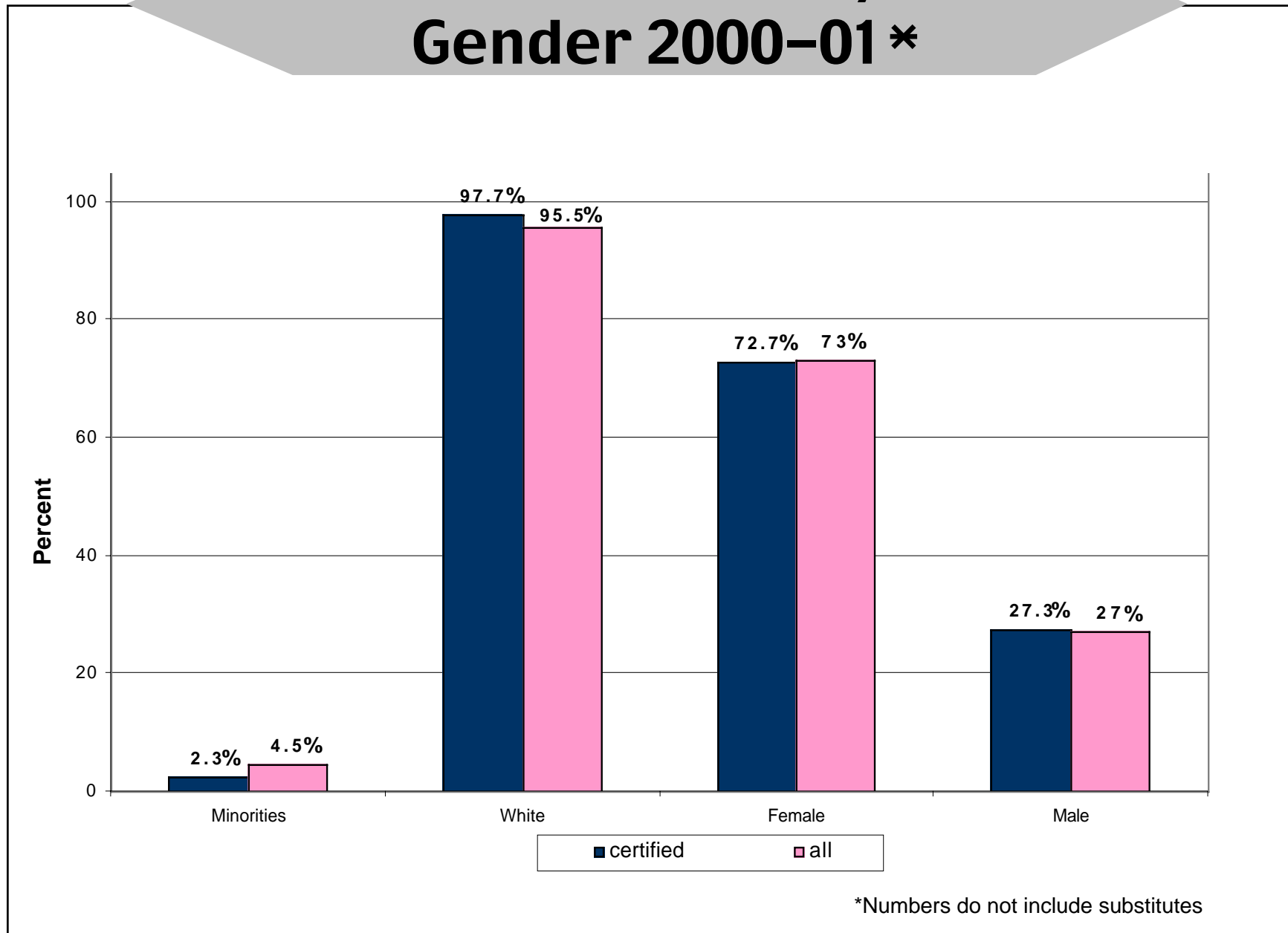

## Opportunities for Staff Development/Involvement

**D**uring the 2000-2001 school year, all GFPS teachers, administrators, and many of the non-certified staff attended district in-service training and state and national conferences in assessment, curriculum, and instruction. Areas of training included math, science, reading, writing, spelling, world languages, technology, vocational education, health enhancement, social studies, library science, and counseling. Other training included the school improvement areas of supervision, program assessment, special education, student behavior, data strategies, and school safety.

In addition:

- Over 150 GFPS teachers and administrators provided their colleagues with district-wide training options in several areas including crisis prevention, reading strategies, assessment, science, writing, and curriculum implementation.
- All GFPS teachers in their first three years of employment received instruction in classroom management, ITIP (Instructional Theory into Practice), Differentiated Classroom (working with all student levels), and mentor training.
- Over 300 certified and non-certified staff, administrators, parents, and community members served on a variety of district committees during the 2000-2001 school.
