Trail Rules and Safety Tips

1. No trail pass is required, skiing/snowshoeing is free for your enjoyment. The trail is classified easy to moderate. There are some mild inclines and declines. Please use caution at all times.
2. For your safety, trail use is **ONE** way. Please observe the Map and direction as posted.
3. Please follow all map, signs or arrows on the ski trail for your safety and others. Ski within your ability and always leave enough space between you and other skiers/snowshoers.
4. Snowshoers will always remain to outside of skier tracks, to the right.
5. Skiers/Snowshoers must **ALWAYS** remain on marked trails. Off trail skiing can damage greens and tees on the golf course. Do not harm wildlife or plants.
6. Please report any safety hazards, vandalism or damage of the facilities to **Keith with Eagle Falls maintenance (406)781-8966**.
7. **NO** Dogs, horses, snowboards, snowmobiles, bicycles, motor vehicles, sleds or alcohol.
8. Ski trail conditions can change rapidly throughout the day. Please use common sense and good judgment.
9. If an injury occurs while on the trail, contact Keith with Eagle Falls maintenance (406)781-8966
10. If snow conditions are not adequate to cover fully any of the area to be skied/snowshoed on, there will be **NO** skiing/snowshoeing until conditions are adequate to do so. This will be POSTED.
11. Pack it in and pack it out.

Designated Use Areas

Trails are depicted on the map. All other areas are considered undesignated for public use and are not inspected. Visitors will limit their activities to designated use areas.
