

Benchmarks for Introduction To Theatre

Develop personal resources
Students will:

- develop an awareness of self discipline, concentration and focus in the theatrical process
- demonstrate intra/interpersonal skills through play study and classroom performance
- explore sensory and emotional perception in the characterization process

Know and manage theatre resources and technology
Students will:

- identify problem solving skills necessary to the craft of developing theatre
- interact with a variety of media and technology sources
- understand the concept of ensemble performance

Create theatre through individual expression and artistic collaboration
Students will:

- rehearse and perform in scripted and unscripted material
- explore movement for the stage
- reflect on preparation and performance

Analyze and form aesthetic judgements
Students will:

- explore theatrical literature through scenes, one-acts, and full length plays
- employ critical thinking skills
- reflect upon the aesthetic qualities of performance/literature

Relate theatre to its social and historical context
Students will:

- place selected works of theatre in a social, historical and cultural context
- understand the critical nature of theatre in its social, historical, and cultural context
