Dear Parent:

As you prepare for your child's entry into school, you need to be aware of immunization requirements for school attendance.

Immunizations are a prerequisite to school entry under Montana Law. Children must be adequately immunized against Diphtheria, Pertussis (Whooping Cough), Tetanus, Polio, Varicella (Chickenpox), Measles, Mumps, and Rubella to attend school. You will be asked to show proof of this at school entry. Immunizations are available through:

- ◆ Your Physician
- ◆ Malmstrom Air Force Base
- ◆ City-County Health Department

The Health Department holds regular shot clinics on Tuesday, 8:30 to 11:30 a.m. and Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday, 8:30 to 11:30 a.m. AND 1:00 to 4:30 p.m. All shot clinics are on a "drop-in" basis; appointments are not necessary.


While not required, it is recommended that your child have a well child, kindergarten exam. These examinations are available through:

- ◆ Your Physician
- ◆ Malmstrom Air Force Base
- ◆ Community Health Care Center located at 115 4th Street South, 454-6973.
