The Board's 8 powers and duties include the broad authority to adopt and enforce all necessary policies for the management and government of the public schools within the District. Except as otherwise 9 10 provided by law, trustees shall hold office for terms of three (3) years, or until their successors are elected and qualified. Terms of trustees shall be staggered as provided by law. 11 12 13 Official action by Board members must occur at a duly called and legally conducted meeting.
