Great Falls School District 1 2 **INSTRUCTION** 2314 3 4 5 Learning Materials Review 6 Citizens objecting to specific materials used in the District are encouraged to submit a complaint 7 8 in writing using form 2314F and discuss the complaint with the building principal prior to 9 pursuing a formal complaint. Complaints should follow the levels established in the Uniform Complaint Procedure (Policy 1770). 10 11 Learning materials, for the purposes of this policy, are considered to be any material used in 12 classroom instruction, library materials, or any materials to which a teacher might refer a student 13 as part of the course of instruction. 14 15 When a citizen's request to remove an item or limit its accessibility is appealed beyond the 16 17 building administrator (Level 3 of the Uniform Complaint Procedure), it will be acted upon, one item at a time, by a Learning Materials Review Committee. The committee will be assembled by 18 the Curriculum Coordinator to include an Executive Director, Curriculum Coordinator, two 19 20 teachers in the department at a different building, and a Board member. Committee members will read the selection in question prior to the committee meeting. 21 22 23 A decision will be delivered to the complainant within ten (10) school days following the last committee meeting.
