- 2 Student Health/Physical Screenings/Examinations
- 3 The Board may arrange each year for health services to be provided to all students. Such services may
- 4 include, but not be limited to:
- 5 1. The development of procedures at each building for the isolation and temporary care of students who become ill during the school day;
- 7 2. Consulting services of a qualified specialist for staff, students, and parents;
- 8 3. Vision, hearing and dental screening;
- 9 4. Scoliosis screening;
- 5. Immunization as provided by the Department of Public Health & Human Services.
- 11 In general the District will notify parents of the specific or approximate dates during the school year when
- screening administered by the District is conducted.
- 13 Parents/guardians will receive written notice of any screening result which indicates a condition that
- might interfere or tend to interfere with a student's progress.
- 15 Students who wish to participate in certain extracurricular activities will be required to submit to a
- 16 physical examination to verify their ability to participate in the activity. Students participating in activities
- 17 governed by the Montana High School Association will be required to follow the rules of that organization,
- as well as other applicable District policies, rules, and regulations.
- 19 All parents will be notified of requirements of the District's policy on physical examinations and screening
- 20 of students, at least annually at the beginning of the school year and within a reasonable period of time
- after any substantive change in the policy.
