2 Student Health/Physical Screenings/Examinations

3 The Board may arrange each year for health services to be provided to all students. Such services may
4 include, but not be limited to:

- 5 1. The development of procedures at each building for the isolation and temporary care of students
6 who become ill during the school day;
- 7 2. Consulting services of a qualified specialist for staff, students, and parents;
- 8 3. Vision, hearing and dental screening;
- 9 4. Scoliosis screening;
- 10 5. Immunization as provided by the Department of Public Health & Human Services.

11 In general the District will notify parents of the specific or approximate dates during the school year when
12 screening administered by the District is conducted.

13 Parents/guardians will receive written notice of any screening result which indicates a condition that
14 might interfere or tend to interfere with a student’s progress.

15 Students who wish to participate in certain extracurricular activities will be required to submit to a
16 physical examination to verify their ability to participate in the activity. Students participating in activities
17 governed by the Montana High School Association will be required to follow the rules of that organization,
18 as well as other applicable District policies, rules, and regulations.

19 All parents will be notified of requirements of the District’s policy on physical examinations and screening
20 of students, at least annually at the beginning of the school year and within a reasonable period of time
21 after any substantive change in the policy.
