5 Equal Education, Nondiscrimination and Sex Equity

7 Equal education opportunities shall be available for all students without regard to race, color,
8 national origin, ancestry, sex, ethnicity, language barrier, religious beliefs, physical and mental
9 handicap or disability, economic or social conditions, or actual or potential marital or parental
10 status, gender identity, sexual orientation, or failure to conform to stereotypical notions of
11 masculinity or femininity.

13 No student will be denied equal access to programs, activities, services, or benefits or be limited
14 in the exercise or any right, privilege, advantage, or denied equal access to educational and
15 extracurricular programs and activities.

17 Inquiries regarding sexual harassment, sex discrimination, or sexual intimidation should be

41 The District, in compliance with federal regulations, will notify annually all students, parents,
42 staff, and community members of this policy and the designated coordinator to receive inquiries.
43 This annual notification will include the name and location of the coordinator and will be
44 included in all handbooks.

1 The District will not tolerate hostile or abusive treatment, derogatory remarks, or acts of violence
2 because of disability against students, staff or volunteers with disabilities. The District considers
3 this behavior to constitute discrimination on the basis of disability in violation of state and
4 federal law.
