Students wishing to form curricular groups or organizations recognized by the school 10 11 administration may do so in accordance with Policy 3510 or 3550. 12 13 This policy shall be made available to all interested individuals upon request and posted on the District's website. Information about the nature and purpose of student clubs and groups meeting 14 at the school and methods to consent to participation or opt out of participation will be provided 15 to parents and families in print or electronic format, consistent with parent/family rights. 16 17 The following guidelines must be met: 18 19 1. The meeting is voluntary and student-initiated. 2. There is no sponsorship of the meeting by the school district, or its agents or employees. 20 21 3. The meeting must occur during non-instructional time on regular school days. 22 4. Employees or agents of the school district are present only in a capacity outside of their 23 official duties. 24 5. The meeting does not materially and substantially interfere with the orderly conduct of 25 educational activities within the school. 6. Non-school persons may not direct, conduct, control, or regularly attend activities. 26 27 28 Although the school assumes no sponsorship of these kinds of meetings, all meetings held on 29 school premises must be scheduled and approved by the principal. 30 This policy pertains to student meetings.
