MTSS provides high-quality, standards-based instruction and intervention that is matched to student's academic, social, emotional, and behavioral needs.

Each school year, the Superintendent or designee will prepare a report on progress toward the <u>District's Strategic Plan</u>. The Board will review and approve the plan and will make it available to the public. District and site level goals and action plans will detail programs, resources, and strategies to be used during the school year.
