- 3 The District shall strive to maintain effective two-way communication channels with the public. Such
- 4 channels shall enable the Board and staff to interpret the schools' needs to the community and provide a
- 5 means for citizens to express their needs and expectations to the Board and staff.
- 6 The Superintendent shall establish and maintain a communication process within the school system, and
- 7 between it and the community. Such public information processes shall provide for news releases at
- 8 appropriate times, news and social media coverage of district programs and events, regular direct
- 9 communications between individual schools and the citizens they serve, and assist staff in improving their
- skill and understanding in communicating with the public.
- 11 The District may solicit community input through a variety of means, including but not limited to: Board
- meetings, Board work sessions, other public meetings, surveys, advisory panels, and other events or
- activities which may bring staff and citizens together.
