

1 **4313 COMMUNITY RELATIONS**

2 Disruption of School Operations

3 Law enforcement officers may be requested to assist in controlling disturbances of the school
4 environment which the Principal, other school administrator, or other staff member in charge has found
5 to be unmanageable and which disturbances have the potential of causing harm to students, other
6 persons, or school property.

7 Such potential of possible disturbance includes members of the public who have exhibited undesirable or
8 illegal conduct on school premises or at a school event held on school property, and who have been
9 requested to leave by an administrator or staff member, but have failed or refused to do so.

10 The Principal, other administrator, or staff member in charge will immediately notify local law
11 enforcement authorities, if any person:

- 12 • Disrupts or obstructs any school program, activity, or meeting or threatens to do so, or
- 13 • Commits, threatens to imminently commit, or incites another to commit any act that will disturb
14 or interfere with or obstruct any lawful task, function, process, or procedure of any student,
15 official, employee, or invitee of the District.

16 The staff member in charge shall make every effort to provide a written report detailing the incident to
17 their supervisor.
