

1 **4331 COMMUNITY RELATIONS**

2 Use of School Property for Distributing and Posting Notices

3 Non-school-related organizations may request permission of the Superintendent or designee to display  
4 posters in the area reserved for community posters or to have flyers distributed to students.

5 Posters and/or flyers must be student oriented and have the sponsoring organization’s name prominently  
6 displayed. The District will not permit the posting or distribution of any material that would:

- 7 A. Disrupt the educational process;
- 8 B. Violate the rights of others;
- 9 C. Invade the privacy of others;
- 10 D. Infringe on a copyright;
- 11 E. Be obscene, vulgar, or indecent; or
- 12 F. Promote the use of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or certain products that create community  
13 concerns.

14 No commercial publication shall be posted or distributed unless the purpose is to further a school  
15 activity. No information from any candidates for non-student elective offices shall be posted in or around  
16 school district property, or distributed through the students. Materials presented as a part of an  
17 instructional lesson or activity may be exempted from this policy.

18 If permission is granted to distribute materials, the organization must arrange to have copies delivered to  
19 the school. The process for distribution of the materials will be arranged by administration.
