The District shall arrange for the substitute to work 8 9 for the absent employee. 10 11 All substitute employees will be required to undergo fingerprint and background checks. All substitute employees are subject to District Policies during their term of service to the District. 12 All substitute employees shall abide by student and staff confidentiality standards during their 13 term of service to the District. 14 15 16 Substitute Certified Staff 17 The Board authorizes the use of substitute teachers that appear on the list to replace teachers who 18 are temporarily absent. The District shall arrange for the substitute to work for the absent 19 20 teacher. Under no condition is a teacher to select or arrange for their own substitute. A substitute teacher may be employed to carry on a teacher's duties not to exceed 35 consecutive teaching 21 22 days. 23 24 If the absence of the regular, licensed or authorized teacher continues for more than 35 consecutive teaching days, the Board of Trustees shall place a licensed teacher under contract or 25 26 seek an emergency authorization of employment. 27 28 The Board annually establishes a daily rate or pay for substitute teachers. No fringe benefits are given to substitute teachers. Teachers under a long-term substitute contract have the option of 29 health insurance, but no other fringe benefits. 30 31 Substitutes for Classified Staff 32 33 34 The Board authorized the use of substitute employees that appear on the list to replace classified employees who are temporarily absent. The District shall arrange for the substitute to work for 35 36 the absent employee. Under no condition is an employee to select or arrange for their own 37 substitute. 38 39 Substitutes for classified positions will be paid by the hour. When a classified employee is called upon to substitute for a teacher, the teacher sub rate shall apply unless the classified rate of pay is 40 41 higher. 42
