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5 Building and Site Acquisition

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7 Constructing, Purchasing or Acquiring Buildings or Sites

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9 The Board may purchase, build, exchange or otherwise acquire buildings and sites. These  
10 actions may not be taken by the Board without the approval of qualified electors at an election  
11 unless:

- 12 • A bond issue has been previously authorized for the purpose of constructing, purchasing,
- 13 or acquiring the site or building;
- 14 • An additional levy under the provisions of MCA 20-9-353 has been approved for the
- 15 purpose of constructing, purchasing or acquiring the site or building;
- 16 • The cost constructing, purchasing or acquiring the site or building is financed without
- 17 exceeding the maximum general fund budget amount and, in the case of a site purchase,
- 18 the site has been approved under the provisions of MCA 20-6-621; or
- 19 • Money is otherwise available and the ballot for the approval of the site for the building
- 20 incorporated a description of the building to be located on the site.

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22 Exchange of Land

23 The Board will consider exchanges of land as provided for by law and in accordance with MCA  
24 20-6-603.

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26 Election

27 When an election is conducted under this policy, it must be called under the provisions of MCA  
28 20-20-201 and must be conducted in the manner prescribed by Montana law.
