- 3 The Board acknowledges its responsibility to develop and implement a curriculum designed to provide for
- 4 sequential intellectual and skill development necessary for students to progress on a continuous basis

- 6 The Superintendent is directed to develop instructional programs which will enable each student to learn
- 7 at the student's best rate. The instructional program will strive to provide for:
- 8 1. Placement of a student at the student's functional level;
  - Learning materials and methods of instruction considered to be most appropriate to the student's learning style;
- 3. Evaluation to determine if the desired student outcomes have been achieved.
- 12 Each year, the Superintendent will determine the degree to which such instructional programs are being
- 13 developed and implemented. Accomplishment reports submitted annually will provide the Board with the
- 14 necessary information to make future program improvement decisions.
