2 Grading and Progress Reports

3 The Board believes that the cooperation of school and home is a vital ingredient in the growth and
4 education of the student and recognizes the responsibility to keep parents informed of student welfare
5 and progress in school.

6 The issuance of grades and progress reports on a regular basis serves as the basis for continuous
7 evaluation of the student's performance and determining changes that should be made to effect
8 improvement. These reports shall be designed to provide information that will be helpful to the student,
9 teacher, counselor and parent.

10 The Board directs the Superintendent to establish a system of reporting student progress and shall require
11 all staff members to comply with such a system as part of their teaching responsibility. Staff members,
12 parents and teachers shall be involved.
