- 3 It is the intent of the District that the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) and all of its
- 4 amendments and changes be complied with by all District employees, vendors, and contractors.
- 5 Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) Management Plan
- 6 An AHERA Management Plan is required by Federal law and is intended to prevent staff exposure to
- 7 asbestos during general operation and maintenance activities. It describes the location and condition of
- 8 asbestos-containing building materials, and documents their removal and repairs. The AHERA
- 9 Management Plan also describes the proper recordkeeping practices that school officials must follow.
- 10 Schools must update their AHERA Management Plans with information collected from their periodic
- surveillance every 6 months, re-inspection of buildings for asbestos-containing materials every 3 years,
- and response actions taken within the school. The AHERA Management Plan is located in Buildings &
- 13 Grounds Department.
