## 1 8456 NON-INSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS

- 2 Security
- 3 Security means not only maintenance of buildings, but also protection from personal risk, fire hazards,
- 4 faulty equipment and safe practices in the use of electrical, plumbing, and heating equipment. The Board
- 5 encourages close cooperation with local police, fire, and sheriff departments and with insurance company
- 6 inspectors.
- 7 Access to school buildings and grounds outside of regular school hours shall be limited to staff whose
- 8 work requires access. An adequate key control system shall be established which shall limit access to
- 9 buildings to authorized staff and shall safeguard against the potential entry of unauthorized persons.
- 10 Records and funds shall be kept in a safe place and under lock and key when required.
- 11 Locks and other protective devices designed to be used as safeguards against illegal entry and vandalism
- 12 shall be installed when appropriate to the individual situation. Employment of watchmen may be
- 13 approved in situations where special risks are involved. All incidents of vandalism and burglary shall be
- reported to the Superintendent immediately and to law enforcement agencies as appropriate.
