

1 **8420 NON-INSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS**

2 District-Wide Asbestos Program

3 It is the intent of the District that the Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) and all of its  
4 amendments and changes be complied with by all District employees, vendors, and contractors.

5 Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) Management Plan

6 An AHERA Management Plan is required by Federal law and is intended to prevent staff exposure to  
7 asbestos during general operation and maintenance activities. It describes the location and condition of  
8 asbestos-containing building materials, and documents their removal and repairs. The AHERA  
9 Management Plan also describes the proper recordkeeping practices that school officials must follow.  
10 Schools must update their AHERA Management Plans with information collected from their periodic  
11 surveillance every 6 months, re-inspection of buildings for asbestos-containing materials every 3 years,  
12 and response actions taken within the school. The AHERA Management Plan is located in Buildings &  
13 Grounds Department.
